Who took part?

• 24 older people who attend exercise classes run by Vibrant Communities, East Ayrshire Council took part.

We asked:

What experiences have you had with the Scottish Parliament?

Very few had any specific experience. Three people had contacted a local MSP and all had a positive response and felt the MSP had worked for them, even when their issue wasn't resolved to their satisfaction.

What do you think about the Scottish Parliament and how it works?

- There is general cynicism about the Parliament and politicians and whether the parliament has made a difference to our lives.
- A few actions of the Parliament were seen as positive by some in the group (free prescriptions, tuition fees and social care).
- Some felt the Parliament didn't use the powers it has.

Are you clear about the difference between Parliament and Government?

- Most people tended not to distinguish between the government and Parliament
- A few people felt they understood the distinction
- Some people found the relationship between UK and Scottish Parliaments and governments unclear
